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Burnhope Parish Council cemetery is run by the Parish Council (the burial authority) and is located in Holmside Lane. The Parish Council cemetery grounds border St. John's Church graveyard. The Parish Council cemetery has no association with the Church nor vice versa. There are no Commonwealth War graves in the Parish Council cemetery.

As the cemetery is managed by the burial authority, Burnhope Parish Council, the Parish Council has a number of legal responsibilities it must comply with in the way it manages, maintains and operates the cemetery.

As such the governing document, Burnhope Parish Council Cemetery Rules & Regulations, details all cemetery rules & regulations that come into effect on the 1st September, 2025. This is published so that it is readily available to all interested parties and partners with whom the Parish Council works, including families, funeral directors, memorial masons and grounds maintenance contractors.

The Parish Council requires that anyone using the Cemetery observes these Rules and Regulations to enable the cemetery to be maintained to a safe high standard for the benefit of all visitors and those that work in the Cemetery. The general rules and regulations are available to download or view on the Parish Council website along with specific information on Fees, Memorial Safety and Exclusive Right of Burial.
